

BARHAM MPS PROGRESS FROM THE AIR

Construction work on the \$20 million Barham Multipurpose Service (MPS) is on schedule.

This month will see the installation of the roof sheeting and services rough-in.

It follows the completion of the concrete pours as well as the installation of the wall and roof framing for the main MPS facility.

The MPS is due to be operational in early 2020.

All services have been operational at the Barham Hospital during this time and will continue.

The new facility will include six inpatient beds, incorporating palliative care, and two beds in the Emergency Department.

There are also 20 aged care beds being built at Murray Haven Homes which is an increase in aged care beds in Barham by 10.
