The MPS is due to be operational in early 2020.

MURRAY HAVEN HOMES

Construction work is progressing at Murray Haven Homes (MHH) with the addition of a 20-bed extension, expected to be completed in early 2019.

The extension includes five beds in the McConnell Wing a secure dementia unit and 15 beds in the Wakool Wing aged care unit.

Eliza House residents will be moving in to their new rooms in the first quarter of next year.

MHH residents have been enjoying watching the building progress and talking to the “tradies” on-site.

At MHH’s Annual General Meeting on Wednesday 17 October, MHH financial members will be given a site tour of the new extension.

Once the extension is officially completed, the community will be invited to an Open Day.

AGEING IN PLACE

Murray Haven Homes is an “Ageing in Place” facility which is a term used to describe a person living in a residence of their choice, for as long as they are able, as they age.

This includes being able to have any services (or other support) they might need over time as their needs change.
