When the facility becomes operational next month, only current Bonalbo Hospital services will be transferred. The residential aged care beds and inpatient beds will become operational once Stage 2 of construction is completed.

Stage 2 comprises the kitchen and laundry facilities required to operationally open the inpatient and aged care beds.

The project is due for completion late 2018.
