

Redevelopment plans go on display

Thank you to everyone who came to the community drop-in sessions in early December and viewed the plans for the redevelopment of the Murrurundi Wilson Memorial Hospital. The project team received great feedback about the new build and refurbishment options.

The redevelopment project aims to bring the ageing infrastructure at the hospital up to modern healthcare standards, and allow for the introduction of enhanced models of care.

Based on previous community feedback that the current site should be used for the location of the redevelopment, the project team presented two concept design options at the information sessions.

There was good attendance and feedback across the two days on the two concept designs, and feedback is still being taken on the plans until mid-February 2019.
