Starting the count down to the completion of the new MPS

The Braidwood MPS Redevelopment site remains open, and work continues in line with the latest advice from the NSW Government. The project remains on track for construction to be completed this year.



Preliminary information for residents and families



Where is the redevelopment of the Braidwood MPS up to?

The Braidwood MPS is due to open by September 2020.

What does this mean for residents?

Once the building works are complete we will be inviting residents and one family member or friend to walk through the new building to have a look through the facility including the resident's allocated bedroom.

In the meantime, these photos show some of the rooms nearing completion.



What support will be offered during the move process?

Additional staff will be rostered during the move and unpacking process.

Will residents choose their new room?

We will be working closely with residents to allocate rooms.

What will the new rooms be like?

All new bedrooms are single with ensuites and have been designed and constructed to current standards. All rooms have large windows overlooking either the courtyard or surrounding countryside.

What's coming up

When construction of the new Health Service is complete, the contractor will hand over the building and the project team prepares for the new MPS to become fully operational.

Over the coming weeks more information will be provided to help residents and families to prepare for the move into the new residential aged care wing.

Once the new Health Service is complete and operational, attention will move to demolishing the old hospital, landscaping the outdoor spaces, and building the new staff accommodation units.
