YOUR NEW HOSPITAL

Cobar, your new hospital is nearly ready. Construction is complete and we are doing the final testing of services before we move in.

At 8am on 30 January 2020, the new Cobar Health Service will be operational and open to the public.

A community walk through will be hosted by the Cobar Health Service on **Thursday 23 January 2020** from 10-11am to help familiarise the local community with the new hospital. More information on the walkthrough will be available closer to the time.

We appreciate your patience and understanding during this busy yet exciting time for Cobar Health Service, and look forward to your feedback on the new hospital.

Services

The new Cobar Health Service will house all of the existing hospital services, including Community Health under one roof.

Parking

The public hospital carpark is located off Woodiwiss Avenue, and the hospital main entry leads off the Woodiwiss Ave carpark.

Access

All hospital access, including emergencies, is via the main entry, both during business hours and after hours. There is an intercom at the main entry for after hour access.



KEY FEATURES OF THE NEW COBAR HEALTH SERVICE

Cobar, your new hospital includes the following services and improvements:

- Emergency Department, including a second critical care camera to support patient care
- 10-bed Inpatient Unit
- Medical Imaging (X-ray)
- Community Health, which is now co-located and includes dental, allied health, child and family health, as well as multiple specialised rooms for outreach services
- Gym for multi-use
- Increased capacity for renal dialysis

- Artwork and signage designed specifically for Cobar with community involvement
- Access to CT and breast screen services via a visiting mobile unit
- Upgraded staff accommodation
- Two courtyards, including a dedicated Aboriginal Courtyard, and a low water usage landscaping design with potential to increase plantings in the future (subject to local water restrictions)
- Staff access to the adjoining Lilliane Brady Village, providing a physical link between the acute health services and residential aged care services.
