Welcome to the Tumbarumba Multipurpose Service (MPS) Open Day.

The \$32 million Tumbarumba MPS is part of the NSW Government's \$300 million MPS Strategy Stage 5, which is improving access to health and aged care services in rural communities.

The program aims to enhance the sustainability and coordination of local healthcare services in rural communities, delivering flexible and integrated health services.

WHAT WILL THE PROJECT DELIVER?

The Tumbarumba MPS will provide a range of integrated health services including:

- a new inpatient wing
- refurbishment of the existing residential aged care wing
- a new aged wing
- An expanded Emergency Department (ED)

There will also be a new and expanded Community Health area and a lounge area for families of Palliative Care and other patients.
