## PROGRESS REPORT

Work on the Tumbarumba Multipurpose Service (MPS) is progressing with the latest construction stage involving work on the facility's footings as the (photo above and right) shows.

This phase of the project also includes the installation of essential services such as water, electricity and medical gases.

Once that is complete, the installation of framing for the main facility can begin.

Construction of the \$32 million MPS is due to be completed in 2020.
