Concrete foundations and floors nearing completion

Construction of the new Bonalbo Multipurpose Service (MPS) continues on schedule, with the concrete ground floor due for completion by the end of May.

The first stage of construction will comprise the 15 Aged Care Residential Beds, the main entrance, and the Emergency Department. Stage 2 comprises the ambulance bay, support services, and staff accommodation. Stage 2 will commence once existing services are relocated into Stage 1 and the existing hospital is clear for demolition.



Despite unseasonal heavy rainfalls, progress on the concrete floor is on schedule.

Four age groups were identified, with each age range


