### **New South West Wing**

The redevelopment at Coolah is continuing and has reached a milestone in the relocation of residents from existing aged care rooms.

The relocation is part of the ongoing development plan and is enabling work to take place on the Residential Aged Care entrance and dining room areas.

While work is underway on the new Residential Aged Care entrance access to the new South West Wing is via the main hospital or ambulance bay entry. Note at various stages entry points may vary dependant on work being undertaken.

Residents who have been relocated to the new 'Rosella Place' wing have all been very positive about the new rooms. They are much larger and have lovely views to the East with ensuite bathrooms. There is also a hairdressing salon and activity (temporarily being used as the dining room) area in the new wing.

#### **Work continues**

The Residential Aged Care entry and dining area is progressing, with the North East Wing 'Magnolia House' almost complete but not accessible until the dining area is finished.

Upgrades to the fire system are in place with the new tanks visible to the pubic near the front visitor's carpark.

Redevelopment work is planned to commence on the reception area and medical centre within the next few months. Work on the acute inpatient rooms will also commence soon.
