Finishing touches being applied at Coolah MPS

Construction works for the Coolah MPS redevelopment are coming to a close, with the final stage of the redevelopment nearing completion. This stage has focused on refurbishment of the GP clinic, administration spaces, landscaping and a new automatic door for the MPS front entry.

Earlier stages of the project delivered the residential aged care wings – Rosella Place and Magnolia House, as well as a new entry, dining and activities spaces for the aged care section, refurbishment of acute rooms, and a new reception and waiting area for the MPS.

Health Service Manager Sue Berry said she is excited about the benefits the upgraded facility will provide for staff and residents, and thanked everyone for their patience and understanding during the redevelopment.

"I'm sure the residents will miss the daily buzz and activity of the building, however it will be a little quieter now," Sue added.

"In addition to the modern facilities, we were also fortunate to receive new artwork and signage to support healing and cultural inclusion, which we will be showcasing at the official opening."
