

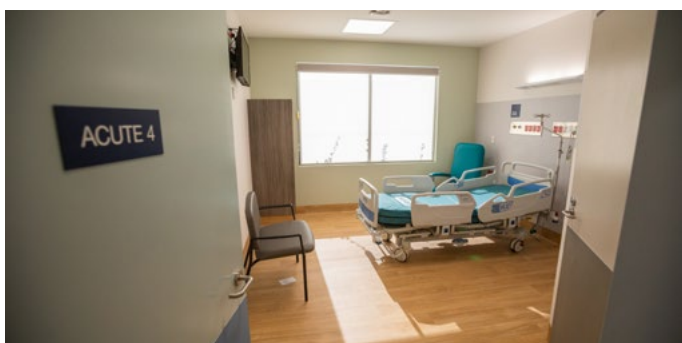


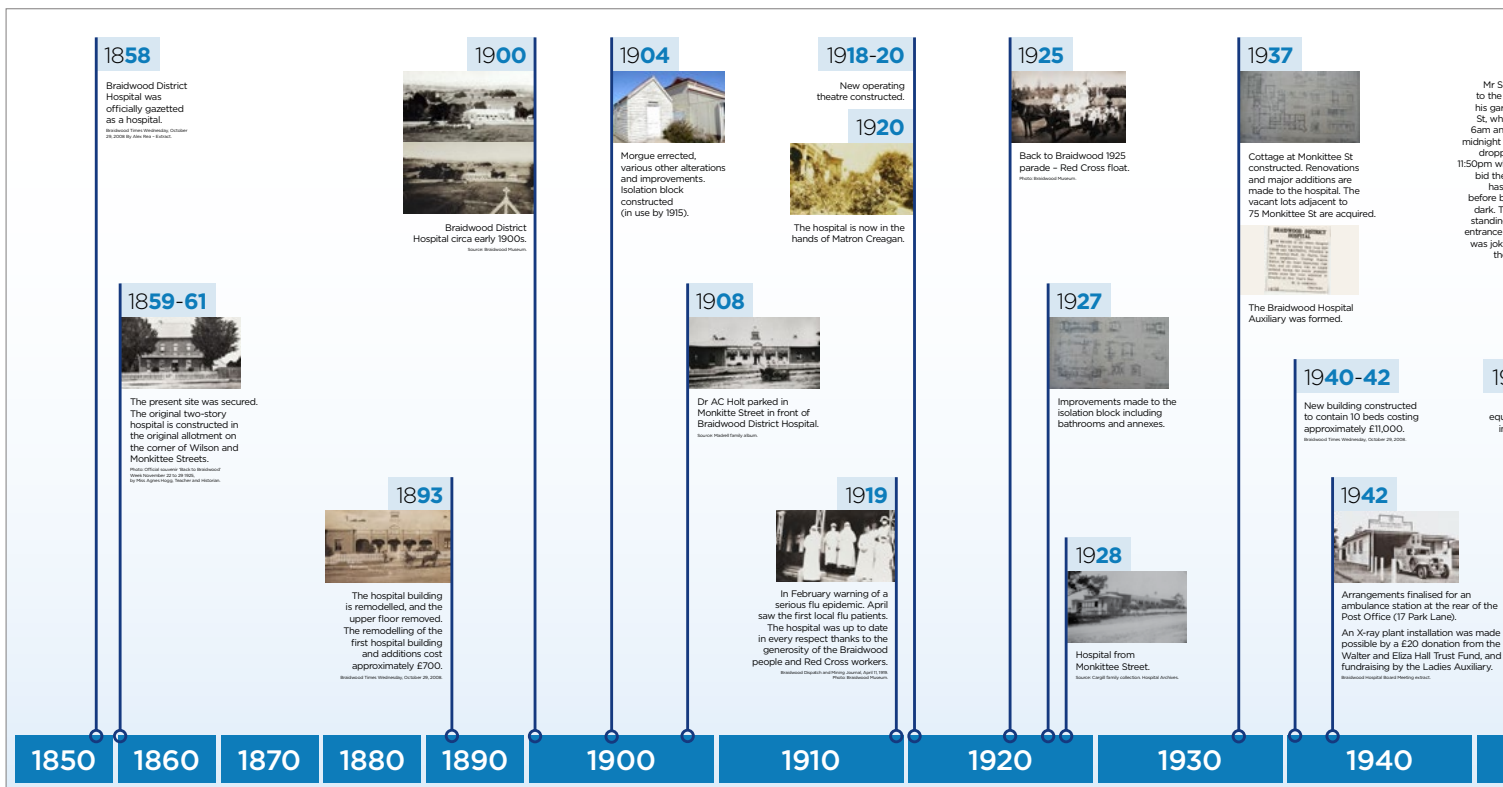
2021 Project Completion

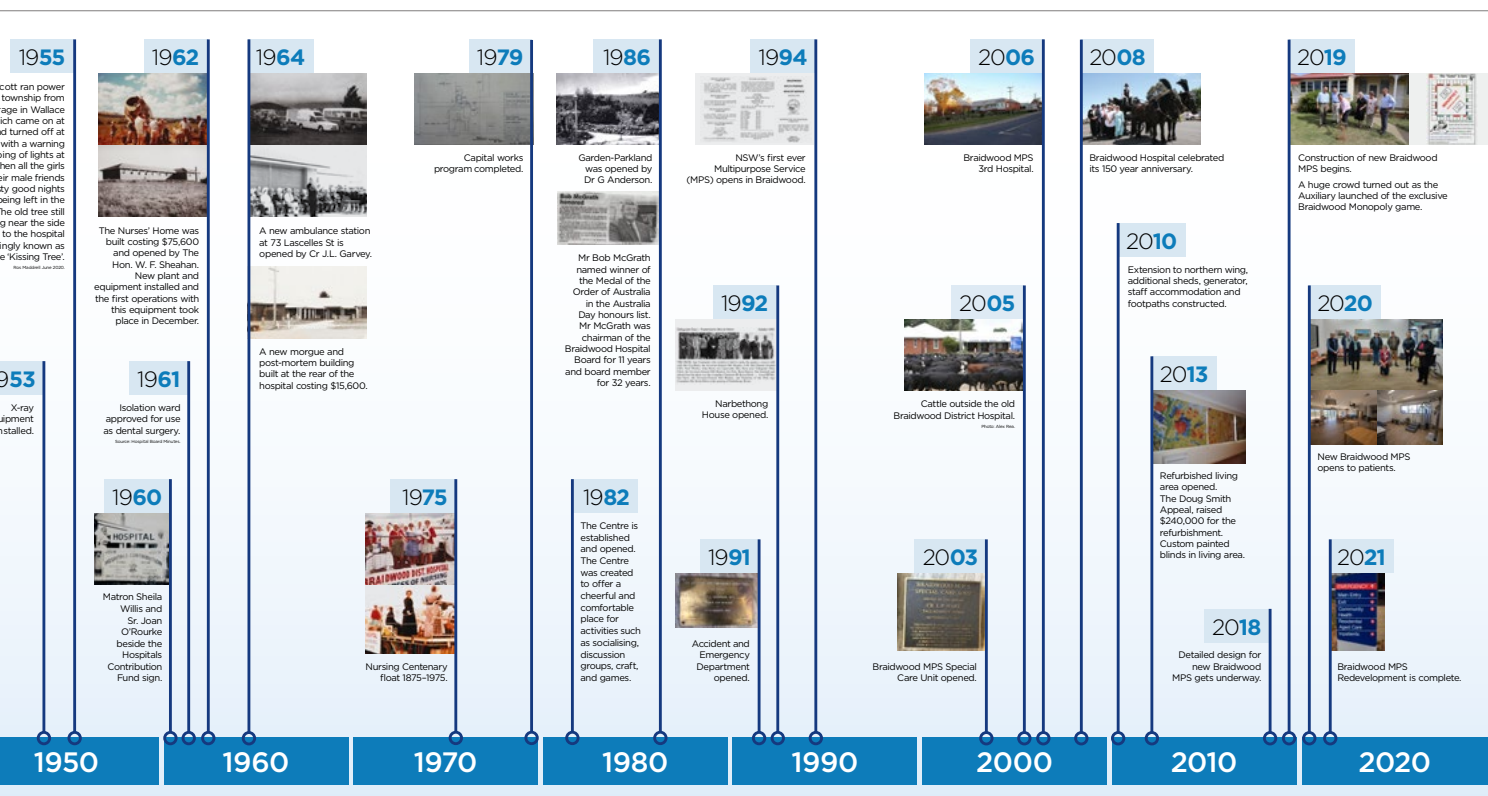
