Members of the Molong Multipurpose Service (MPS) redevelopment team recently spoke to community members at a local school and the HealthOne in Bank Street about their ideas for art and signage at the MPS.

Deb Kenna, Health Service Manager at the Molong MPS, is also keen to hear from anyone who couldn't make it to the consultation sessions held recently.

"Stage 1 of the build is nearing completion and will include the new Residential Aged Care section, as well as a new courtyard, which is very exciting, particularly for our residents," Deb said.

"At this point in the project, we're seeking input from the entire Molong community on artwork, signage and other ideas to make the Molong MPS a more welcoming place for all.

"An online survey has been created for everyone to have the opportunity to provide their ideas – it's simple and easy – all you need to do is go online, and fill in answers to six short questions.

"Local input is really valuable and will inform the look and feel of the art within the redeveloped areas as well as signage around the MPS."

Where is the Molong MPS redevelopment up to?

Current progress (as of March 2017):

Main works commenced June 2016. Works completed and in progress to date include:

- \Rightarrow Pouring of concrete slab
- ⇒ Structural frames have been erected
- \Rightarrow Roofing has been installed
- \Rightarrow Brickwork is near completion
- ⇒ Services rough-in and internal works for the new Residential Aged Care wing is continuing

Next steps:

- ⇒ Engineering services works and internal works will be progressed
- ⇒ Completion of the new Residential
 Aged Care wing and courtyard
- ⇒ Refurbishment works to areas within the existing hospital will commence following the Residential Aged Care area
- ⇒ Completion of Molong MPS redevelopment in late 2017
