## Opportunity to view progress on the redevelopment plans



Monday 3 December, 3.00pm-6.00pm Tuesday 4 December, 8.30am-10.30am at Murrurundi CWA Hall

The Murrurundi community is invited to view the redevelopment plans of their Wilson Memorial Hospital at the upcoming community drop-in and information sessions.

Significant planning and investigation has occurred following the NSW Government announcement in September 2017 to redevelop the hospital. The redevelopment is being funded as part of the state-wide Multipurpose Service (MPS) Program.

A key aim of the redevelopment project is to bring the ageing infrastructure at the hospital up

to modern healthcare standards, which will allow for the introduction of enhanced models of care.

Based on community feedback that the current site should be used for the location of the redevelopment, the project team working on the redevelopment has developed a master plan and concept design.

The project team is now ready to share where the project is up to and is inviting the community to attend drop-in sessions.

# What's going to be included in your new hospital?

The redevelopment will deliver:

- An inpatient unit consisting of single rooms and a flexible ward
- Emergency services consisting of resuscitation bay, treatment bay and triage bay
- Community health services consisting of consultation rooms, an allied health treatment room and a multipurpose room
- Staff accommodation
- Ambulance bay

The focus of the redevelopment is on providing modern facilities to meet the needs of the local community. This includes delivering an increase in primary and ambulatory care services.

The facility will retain the current name of Wilson Memorial Hospital.
