Seeking Talented Lightning Ridge Local Aboriginal Artists

Local Aboriginal artists are invited to submit a portfolio of their work to be considered for Lightning Ridge Hospital's Aboriginal Signage and Artwork project.

Featuring local Aboriginal artwork in the Hospital is an opportunity both for the artist to showcase their work, and to be a part of building the strong cultural connection between our hospital and our community.

The proposed artwork would include:

- Two large paintings for the main facility health meeting room (located in the new Health One building). The theme for the paintings is to be related to the local Lightning Ridge and surrounding area Aboriginal community, highlighting a local story or important landscape location.
- One large painting for the main reception area (located at the entry to the main building). The theme of the painting is to be of local Aboriginal significance and to be hopeful, calming and soothing.
