

Asbestos Removal from Tuesday 18 April – Thursday 20 April 2023

The Blayney Multipurpose Service (MPS) is undergoing a major redevelopment as part of the NSW Government's \$297 million Multipurpose Service Program to deliver health facilities across rural and remote NSW.

During recent Early Works construction at the Blayney MPS, asbestos or asbestos containing material was identified in the ground on the existing Osman Street site.

Health Infrastructure has engaged **Central West Asbestos Removal** to carry out the removal of the Non-Friable asbestos.

Work times will be between **7.00am and 5.00pm** from **Tuesday 18 April to Thursday 20 April 2023**. We will let you know in advance of any changes to these days and times.

How will the work affect you?

We recognise that building new infrastructure can be disruptive to nearby residents, businesses and road users. All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority.

Asbestos is commonly found on construction sites throughout NSW. As is best practice, asbestos is managed on-site in accordance with Environment Protection Authority requirements.

The removal of asbestos is in accordance with all health and environmental regulations including SafeWork NSW regulations. Notification has been given and approved by SafeWork NSW, and all work will be carried out in accordance with the WH&S Standards required. The Licence details can be confirmed and more information found at safework.nsw.gov.au

The affected area is safely isolated within the fenced compound of the work site.
